SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Baptism is celebrated after consultation with the parish staff as to date. Registered membership in the parish and attendance at a Baptism Class are required for all parents prior to their first child's Baptism.

Holy Communion

A two-year required sacramental preparation process begins in the first grade. It culminates in the celebration of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the second grade.

Confirmation

A two-year required sacramental preparation process begins in the sixth/seventh grade. It culminates in the celebration of Confirmation.

Matrimony

A six-month required sacramental preparation process begins when the engaged couple meets with the priest or deacon and culminates in the couple's exchange of consent on their wedding day.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)

A one-year process for preparation and study is required for all those interested in becoming Catholic.

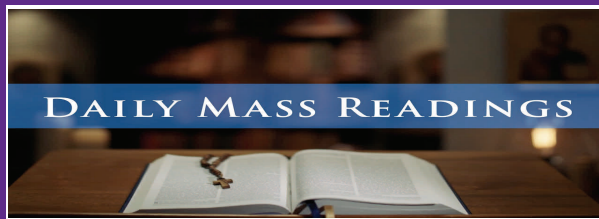

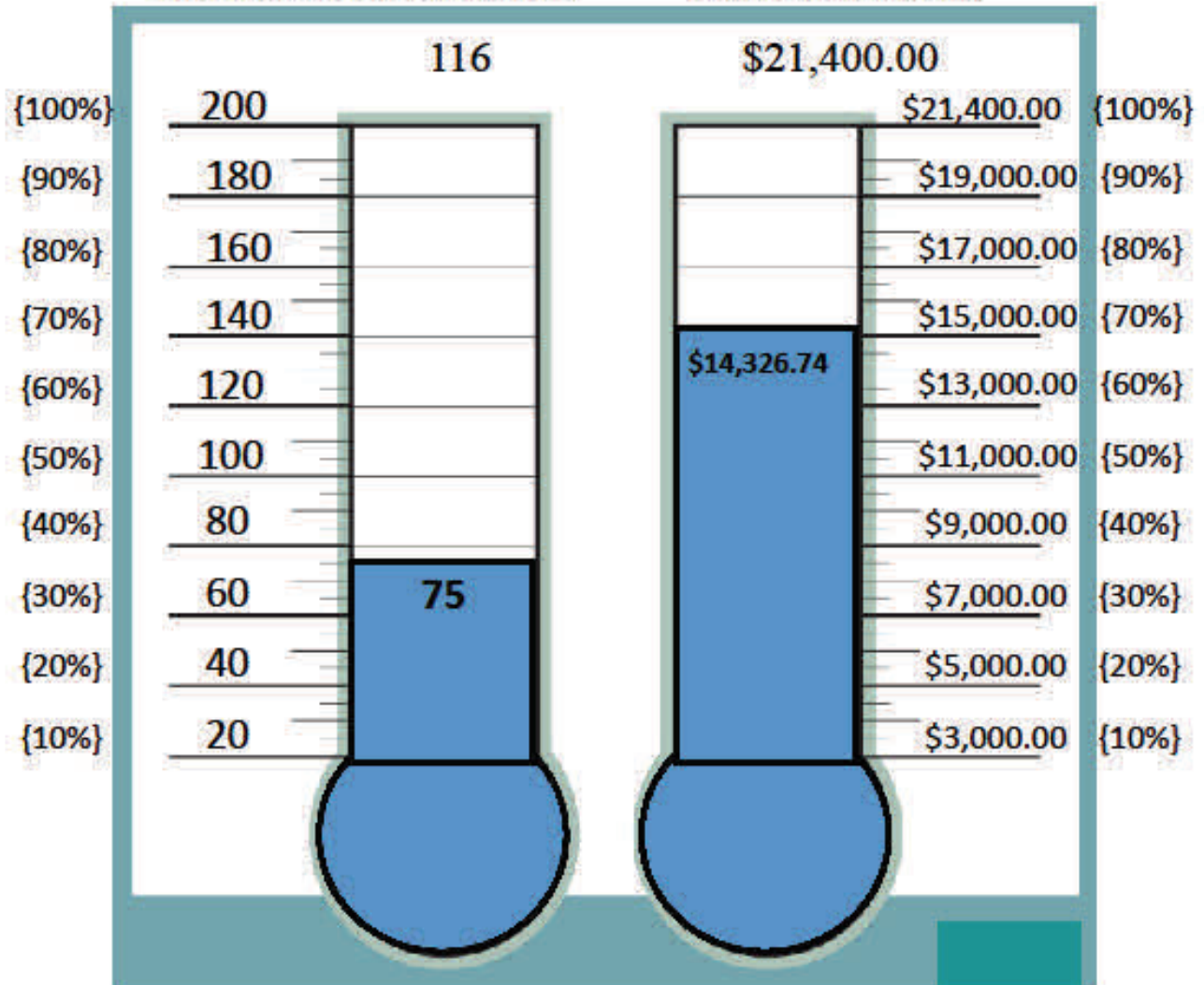

How our parish already practices this goal:

- ◆ Twice a year, Service Committee has a food drive with all donated food products given to the Christian Life Center. Children collect cans of food each week
- ◆ We financially support charity programs through the Diocesan 2nd collections
- ◆ We participate in Rice Bowl Program every year
- ◆ Special Events Committee hosts a back-to-school drive and/or a winter clothing drive each year and given to Family resource Center of Mercer County School
- ◆ Service Committee sets up a Christmas Giving Tree with donations used to purchase gifts to the shut-ins of the parish and residents of the local nursing home and Thompson-Hood Veterans Center in Wilmore, KY.
- ◆ Any food left over from events is packaged up and donated to the Mercer Transformation who feed the homeless in the community daily
- ◆ We are part of the Mercer County Resource Ministry that provides funds to help individuals that do not qualify for other sources of assistance. Our parish volunteer interviews those seeking assistance. We contribute to this group on a quarterly basis. We also keep funds to help any of our members that need assistance.

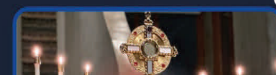

The Divine Mercy Chaplet is prayed every Sun. after the 11 AM Mass, led by Tamme Schroeder.

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas. The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus' promise to come back. But the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas. As we prepare for Christmas, the General Instruction of the Roman Missal notes some differences to the Mass that should be observed during the season. For instance, the priest wears violet or purple during Advent, except for the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) when rose may be worn. Aside from what the priest wears, other aesthetic changes in the Church can include a more modestly decorated altar. The final days of Advent, from December 17 to December 24, we focus on our preparation for the celebrations of the Nativity of our Lord at Christmas. In particular, the "O" Antiphons are sung during this period and have been by the Church since at least the eighth century. They are a magnificent theology that uses ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming of Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but of present ones as well. Advent devotions including the Advent wreath, remind us of the meaning of the season.
